Because Wanting to Stop is NOT Enough!

PROGRAM:

This domestic violence/batterer intervention program uses the EMERGE model and components of the STOP program. Founded in 1977, Emerge was the first abuser education program in the United States. Emerge teaches domestic violence is a learned behavior, not a disease or a sickness and supports efforts to stop partner violence, sexual assault and child abuse. The STOP program is an internationally recognized psychoeducational, cognitive behavioral based treatment model that includes developing respect for the offender himself—in addition to the victim.



STOP:

- Hitting, pushing, grabbing, threatening your partner/family
- Making your partner and/or children afraid of you
- Punching walls, throwing or breaking things to cause fear
- Pressuring your partner to do anything they don't want to do
- Name calling, swearing, using put-downs to control others
- Making promises to change...but not changing

BEGIN:

- Recognizing harmful behavior towards your partner/family
- Being open and honest about your behaviors
- Exploring strategies to become respectful/non-abusive
- Developing empathy for your partner/family and make
